



U.S. Distilled Spirits Exports: 2016 Factsheet

- In 2016, U.S. distilled spirits totaled \$1.4 billion, making it the tenth consecutive year where exports surpassed the \$1 billion mark. American Whiskey, which includes Bourbon, Tennessee Whiskey, and American Rye Whiskey represent 68 percent of U.S. exports reaching almost \$974.
- The top five export markets for U.S. spirits by value were Canada (\$191 million), United Kingdom (\$122 million), Australia (\$113 million), Spain (\$103 million), and Germany (\$101 million).
- In volume terms, total U.S. spirits exports have increased by 6.7 percent and American Whiskeys increased by 9.5 percent as compared with 2015.
- The top five export markets for U.S. spirits in volume (proof liters) were Canada (59 million), Spain (45 million), Australia (35 million), Germany (20 million), and Mexico.
- The top five export markets above \$10 million by percentage growth were Vietnam (+182.9 percent), Romania (+40 percent), Spain (+20 percent), Singapore (+15.4 percent), and Korea (+12.6 percent).
